Purpose: *To promote quality teaching and enhanced learning in Alexander City Schools. These grants reward educators for developing innovative and useful program ideas with a goal to provide our students with the best education possible.*

Guidelines:

- Any teacher or staff member of the Alexander City Schools district may apply for a grant.
- Proposals may include requests for equipment, consultants, printing/prepared materials or other project costs needed to implement a program for a classroom, a department, or an area of service. The need for equipment must be directly related to objectives of the project.
- Each grant must have a title and a detailed budget must be provided.
- If a teacher transfers to another campus or resigns from the district, the grant award will be returned to the Foundation or the campus principal may select another teacher to carry out the project on the original campus.
- **Grant Applications open Sept. 1, 2023 and close Sept.29, 2023**
- Preference will be given to foundation members
- *Professional Development will not be considered

The ACSEF Teacher Grant Committee will review all applications and select recipients based on a scoring rubric. Adherence to grant specifications will be considered. Recipients will be expected to share results of funded programs with the school system, school faculties and at professional meetings, if requested. A program evaluation will be required at the end of the project.
